At a total cost of around GNF 85,870,000,000 (\$10,000,000), the arrival of this equipment will enable Conakry Terminal to increase its cargo handling capacity by 50% on quay 12. With this investment, Conakry Terminal demonstrates its commitment to modernizing and optimizing its port activities. This acquisition is in line with the company's development strategy, in response to the growing demand for quality port services in the region.
